#### Supervision Requirements

**TABLE 1: SUPERVISION REQUIREMENTS FOR CATEGORY A & B BATHERS**

Category	Description	In-Pool Supervision	Poolside Supervision
A	All Children under 5 years Non/weak swimmers Bathers with special needs	1:1 supervision by an adult who is a confident swimmer	Programmed – one ERC trained supervisor.  Un-programmed – one NPLQ trained supervisor.
B	All children aged 5 to 8 years (These must be confident swimmers, otherwise they must be considered under Category A)	1:2 supervision by an adult who is a confident swimmer	Programmed – one ERC trained supervisor.  Un-programmed – one NPLQ trained supervisor.

In addition to the above, these apply:

TABLE 2: SUPERVISION REQUIREMENTS FOR CATEGORY C & D BATHERS

Category	Description	In-Pool Supervision	Poolside Supervision
C	Young Persons/children aged 9-16 years (These must be confident swimmers, otherwise they must be considered under Category A)	There must be at least two adults supervising, although they don't necessarily have to be in the pool	Programmed – one ERC trained supervisor. Un-programmed – one NPLQ trained supervisor.
D	Young persons/adults over 16 years (These must be confident swimmers, otherwise they must be considered under Category A)	No supervision is required.	Programmed – one ERC trained supervisor. Un-programmed – one NPLQ trained supervisor.

There is a limit of 30 people in the pool at any one time.

2 life guards will be present at each swim session.
